

GCSE-LEVEL SERBIAN COURSE IN LONDON 2016-2017

The Serbian Language course has been designed to meet the requirements of Ofqual, the government body responsible for examinations in England.

It will be run as an intensive course over four terms – January 2016 to March 2017 and taught by qualified and experienced teachers. It will therefore require pupils to have a **working knowledge** of the Serbian language.

Who: Up to 20 pupils aged 12 and over who have some knowledge of Serbian - candidates will be assessed prior to acceptance.

When: Saturday or Sunday afternoons for three hours

Where: Kensington Aldridge Academy, 1 Silchester Road, London W10 6EX

Fees: £200 and an Exam Entrance fee of £40. Fees are paid at the beginning of the course or on a termly basis.

The pupils who complete the course will be externally examined by Dr David Norris and Dr Vladislava Ribnikar from the University of Nottingham. Those successfully completing the course will be issued with a certificate from the SCGB confirming attendance and that the pupil has satisfied GCSE standards in Serbian. This certificate can be included in pupil's record of achievement.
